European Cybersecurity Atlas Platform (Atlas)

The **European Cybersecurity Atlas Platform (Atlas)** is a platform that maps, categorizes, and visualizes information on the Cybersecurity Competence Community (Community) and makes it publicly available. Its goal is to foster the engagement and potential collaboration among Community members in support of the EU Digital Strategy.

Your personal data is processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data¹.

The data controller of the processing operation is the **European Cybersecurity Competence Center ("ECCC")**.

This processing operation relates to Record No 15 – Atlas Platform, available under the [ECCC register of data processing activities](#).

The data processor of the processing operation is the EC DG JRC, responsible for the design, development and maintenance of Atlas, based on an agreement with the ECCC.

The legal basis for the processing operation is article 5(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 (EUDR), on the basis of Regulation EU) 2021/887 establishing the European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre and the Network of National Coordination Centres, especially the provisions establishing the tasks of the ECCC.

The purpose of this processing operation is to map, categorize, and visualize information on the Cybersecurity Competence Community (Community) and its members and make it publicly available.

The following personal data are processed:

- Personal (contact) data of the representative of each Community member, provided by the National Coordination Centre (NCC) that assessed the relevant application, under a data sharing agreement between the NCC and the ECCC: first name, family name, position within the organisation, professional contact email and phone number. *This data is available via Atlas only to NCCs, EC and the ECCC.* Atlas visitors and registered Community members will be able to access details of the Community member and not of the representative.
- Contact data of the Community member (organisation): Address, Phone number and email of the organisation. *This data is not expected to be personal data unless in specific cases such as*

very small organisations.

- Communication via Atlas (contact form or email): First and last name, email address, title/subject and content of your message.
- Personal contact data of designated NCC Point of Contact (POC) and Contact Person responsible on behalf of each NCC to send information to the Atlas platform and receive information on registrations at the Atlas platform (First and Last Name, email address).
- Cookies: Atlas platform uses cookies in accordance with the EC cookies policy².
- Technical information for security and maintenance purposes (log files).

Access to your data is granted only to: designated ECCC, NCC, EC and ECCC processor staff and bodies charged with monitoring or inspection tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, European Anti-fraud Office – OLAF).

Retention periods:

- Contact data of the representative of each Community member will be processed for a time period that equals the appointment of the data subject as a representative of the Community member or the membership of the organisation as a member of the Community.
- Contact data of a Community member will be processed for a time period that equals the membership of the organisation as a member of the Community.
- Contact data of the appointed NCC Point of Contact and Contact Person will be processed for a time period that equals the appointment of data subject from the NCC.
- Personal data from communication via Atlas will be kept up to a maximum period of one year.
- Cookies are retained as per the relevant EC cookies policy².
- Technical information for security and maintenance purposes (log files) are retained for 42 days.

Storage and transfers of personal data: All personal data will be processed only within EU/EEA and no transfers outside EU/EEA are foreseen.

Security of personal data: All personal data in electronic format (e-mails, documents, databases, uploaded batches of data, etc.) are stored on the servers of the European Commission. All processing operations are carried out pursuant to the Commission Decision (EU, Euratom) 2017/46 of 10 January 2017 on the security of communication and information systems in the European Commission.

You have the right of access to your personal data and to relevant information concerning how we use it. You have the right to rectify your personal data. Under certain conditions, you have the right to ask that we delete your personal data or restrict its use. You have the right to object to our processing of your personal data, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time. We will consider your request, take a decision and communicate it to you.
